

Galilean Ministry—A Demon in the Synagogue (Winter 30 – Spring 31)

Mark 1:21b–28	Luke 4:31b–37
<p>21b and immediately on the Sabbath He entered the synagogue and <i>began</i> to teach. 22 They were amazed at His teaching; for He was teaching them as <i>one</i> having authority, and not as the scribes. 23 Just then there was a man in their synagogue with an unclean spirit; and he cried out, 24 saying,</p> <p>“What business do we have with each other, Jesus of Nazareth? Have You come to destroy us? I know who You are—the Holy One of God!” 25 And Jesus rebuked him, saying, “Be quiet, and come out of him!” 26 Throwing him into convulsions, the unclean spirit cried out with a loud voice and came out of him. 27 They were all amazed, so that they debated among themselves, saying, “What is this? A new teaching with authority! He commands even the unclean spirits, and they obey Him.” 28 Immediately the news about Him spread everywhere into all the surrounding district of Galilee.</p>	<p>31b and He was teaching them on the Sabbath; 32 and they were amazed at His teaching, for His message was with authority.</p> <p>33 In the synagogue there was a man possessed by the spirit of an unclean demon, and he cried out with a loud voice,</p> <p>34 “Let us alone! What business do we have with each other, Jesus of Nazareth? Have You come to destroy us? I know who You are—the Holy One of God!” 35 But Jesus rebuked him, saying, “Be quiet and come out of him!” And when the demon had thrown him down in the midst <i>of the people</i>, he came out of him without doing him any harm. 36 And amazement came upon them all, and they <i>began</i> talking with one another saying, “What is this message? For with authority and power He commands the unclean spirits and they come out.” 37 And the report about Him was spreading into every locality in the surrounding district.</p>

<p>14 When Jesus came into Peter’s home, He saw his mother-in-law lying sick in bed with a fever. 15 He touched her hand, and the fever left her; and she got up and waited on Him.</p>	<p>29 And immediately after they came out of the synagogue, they came into the house of Simon and Andrew, with James and John. 30 Now Simon’s mother-in-law was lying sick with a fever; and immediately they spoke to Jesus about her. 31 And He came to her and raised her up, taking her by the hand, and the fever left her, and she waited on them.</p>	<p>38 Then He got up and <i>left</i> the synagogue, and entered Simon’s home. Now Simon’s mother-in-law was suffering from a high fever, and they asked Him to help her. 39 And standing over her, He rebuked the fever, and it left her; and she immediately got up and waited on them.</p>
