Matthew 4:23–25	Mark 1:35–39	Luke 4:42–44
<p>23 Jesus was going throughout all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues and proclaiming the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every kind of disease and every kind of sickness among the people.</p> <p>24 The news about Him spread throughout all Syria; and they brought to Him all who were ill, those suffering with various diseases and pains, demoniacs, epileptics, paralytics; and He healed them.</p> <p>25 Large crowds followed Him from Galilee and <i>the</i> Decapolis and Jerusalem and Judea and <i>from</i> beyond the Jordan.</p>	<p>35 In the early morning, while it was still dark, Jesus got up, left <i>the house</i>, and went away to a secluded place, and was praying there.</p> <p>36 Simon and his companions searched for Him;</p> <p>37 they found Him, and said to Him, “Everyone is looking for You.”</p> <p>38 He said to them, “Let us go somewhere else to the towns nearby, so that I may preach there also; for that is what I came for.”</p> <p>39 And He went into their synagogues throughout all Galilee, preaching</p> <p style="text-align: center;">and casting out the demons.</p>	<p>42 When day came, Jesus left and went to a secluded place; and the crowds were searching for Him, and came to Him and tried to keep Him from going away from them.</p> <p>43 But He said to them, “I must preach the kingdom of God to the other cities also, for I was sent for this purpose.”</p> <p>44 So He kept on preaching in the synagogues</p> <p style="text-align: right;">of Judea.</p>

And immediately the leprosy left him.</p> <p>14 And He ordered him to tell no one, "But go and show yourself to the priest and make an offering for your cleansing, just as Moses commanded, as a testimony to them."</p> <p>15 But the news about Him was spreading even farther, and large crowds were gathering to hear <i>Him</i> and to be healed of their sicknesses.</p> <p>16 But Jesus Himself would <i>often</i> slip away to the wilderness and pray.</p>
