

Galilean Ministry—Jairus' Daughter Restored (Winter 31/32)

Matthew 9:23–26	Mark 5:35–43	Luke 8:49–56
<p>23 When Jesus came into the official's house, and saw the flute-players and the crowd in noisy disorder,</p> <p>24 He said, "Leave; for the girl has not died, but is asleep." And they <i>began</i> laughing at Him.</p> <p>25 But when the crowd had been sent out, He entered and took her by the hand, and the girl got up.</p>	<p>35 While He was still speaking, they came from the <i>house of</i> the synagogue official, saying, "Your daughter has died; why trouble the Teacher anymore?"</p> <p>36 But Jesus, overhearing what was being spoken, said to the synagogue official, "Do not be afraid <i>any longer</i>, only believe."</p> <p>37 And He allowed no one to accompany Him, except Peter and James and John the brother of James.</p> <p>38 They came to the house of the synagogue official; and He saw a commotion, and <i>people</i> loudly weeping and wailing.</p> <p>39 And entering in, He said to them, "Why make a commotion and weep? The child has not died, but is asleep."</p> <p>40 They <i>began</i> laughing at Him. But putting them all out, He took along the child's father and mother and His own companions, and entered <i>the room</i> where the child was.</p> <p>41 Taking the child by the hand, He said to her, "Talitha kum!" (which translated means, "Little girl, I say to you, get up!").</p> <p>42 Immediately the girl got up and <i>began</i> to walk, for she was twelve years old. And immediately they were completely astounded.</p> <p>43b and He said that <i>something</i> should be given her to eat.</p>	<p>49 While He was still speaking, someone came from <i>the house of</i> the synagogue official, saying, "Your daughter has died; do not trouble the Teacher anymore."</p> <p>50 But when Jesus heard <i>this</i>, He answered him, "Do not be afraid <i>any longer</i>; only believe, and she will be made well."</p> <p>51 When He came to the house, He did not allow anyone to enter with Him, except Peter and John and James, and the girl's father and mother.</p> <p>52 Now they were all weeping and lamenting for her; but He said, "Stop weeping, for she has not died, but is asleep."</p> <p>53 And they <i>began</i> laughing at Him, knowing that she had died.</p> <p>54 He, however, took her by the hand and called, saying, "Child, arise!"</p> <p>55a And her spirit returned, and she got up immediately;</p> <p>56a Her parents were amazed; 55b and He gave orders for <i>something</i> to be given her to eat.</p>
