<p>1 At that time the disciples came to Jesus and said, “Who then is greatest in the kingdom of heaven?”</p> <p>2 And He called a child to Himself and set him before them,</p> <p>3 and said, “Truly I say to you, unless you are converted and become like children, you will not enter the kingdom of heaven.</p> <p>4 “Whoever then humbles himself as this child, he is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven.</p> <p>5 And whoever receives one such child in My name receives Me;</p>	<p>33 They came to Capernaum; and when He was in the house, He <i>began</i> to question them, “What were you discussing on the way?”</p> <p>34 But they kept silent, for on the way they had discussed with one another which <i>of them was</i> the greatest.</p> <p>35 Sitting down, He called the twelve and said to them, “If anyone wants to be first, he shall be last of all and servant of all.”</p> <p>36 Taking a child, He set him before them, and taking him in His arms, He said to them,</p> <p>37 “Whoever receives one child like this in My name receives Me; and whoever receives Me does not receive Me, but Him who sent Me.”</p>	<p>46 An argument started among them as to which of them might be the greatest.</p> <p>47 But Jesus, knowing what they were thinking in their heart,</p> <p>took a child and stood him by His side,</p> <p>48 and said to them,</p> <p>“Whoever receives this child in My name receives Me, and whoever receives Me receives Him who sent Me; for the one who is least among all of you, this is the one who is great.”</p>

<p>It is better for you to enter life with one eye, than to have two eyes and be cast into the fiery hell.</p> <p>10 See that you do not despise one of these little ones, for I say to you that their angels in heaven continually see the face of My Father who is in heaven.</p> <p>11 [For the Son of Man has come to save that which was lost.]</p> <p>12 What do you think?
