Matthew 22:41–46	Mark 12:34b–37	Luke 20:40–44
<p>41 Now while the Pharisees were gathered together, Jesus asked them a question:</p> <p>42 “What do you think about the Christ, whose son is He?”</p> <p>They said to Him, “<i>The son of David.</i>”</p> <p>43 He said to them,</p> <p>“Then how does David in the Spirit call Him ‘Lord,’ saying,</p> <p>44 ‘THE LORD SAID TO MY LORD, “SIT AT MY RIGHT HAND, UNTIL I PUT YOUR ENEMIES BENEATH YOUR FEET”?’ [Ps 110:1]</p> <p>45 If David then calls Him ‘Lord,’ how is He his son?”</p> <p>46 No one was able to answer Him a word, nor did anyone dare from that day on to ask Him another question.</p>	<p>35 And Jesus <i>began</i> to say, as He taught in the temple,</p> <p>“<i>How is it that</i> the scribes say that the Christ is the son of David?</p> <p>36 David himself said in the Holy Spirit,</p> <p>‘THE LORD SAID TO MY LORD, “SIT AT MY RIGHT HAND, UNTIL I PUT YOUR ENEMIES BENEATH YOUR FEET.”’</p> <p>37a David himself calls Him ‘Lord’; so in what sense is He his son?”</p> <p>34b After that, no one would venture to ask Him any more questions.</p> <p>37b And the large crowd enjoyed listening to Him.</p>	<p>41 Then He said to them,</p> <p>“<i>How is it that</i> they say the Christ is David’s son?</p> <p>42 “For David himself says in the book of Psalms,</p> <p>‘THE LORD SAID TO MY LORD, “SIT AT MY RIGHT HAND, UNTIL I PUT YOUR ENEMIES BENEATH YOUR FEET.”’</p> <p>44 “Therefore David calls Him ‘Lord,’ and how is He his son?”</p> <p>40 For they did not have courage to question Him any longer about anything.</p>
