# Jesus' Royal Jewish Lineage (mid 3 BC)

#### Matthew 1:1–17

#### Introduction

1 This is the record of the genealogy of Jesus Christ, the son of David, the son of Abraham.

#### **Abraham to David**

- 2 Abraham was the father of Isaac, Isaac the father of Jacob, Jacob the father of Judah and his brothers,
- 3 Judah the father of Perez and Zerah (by Tamar), Perez the father of Hezron, Hezron the father of Ram,
- 4 Ram the father of Amminadab, Amminadab the father of Nahshon, Nahshon the father of Salmon,
- 5 Salmon the father of Boaz (by Rahab), Boaz the father of Obed (by Ruth), Obed the father of Jesse,
- 6a and Jesse the father of David the king. [cf. 1 Chr 2:3-15]

## David to Exile (Jeconiah/Jehoiachin)

- 6b David was the father of Solomon (by the wife of Uriah),
- 7 Solomon the father of Rehoboam, Rehoboam the father of Abijah, Abijah the father of Asa,
- 8 As a the father of Jehoshaphat, Jehoshaphat the father of Joram, Joram the father of Uzziah,
- 9 Uzziah the father of Jotham, Jotham the father of Ahaz, Ahaz the father of Hezekiah,
- 10 Hezekiah the father of Manasseh, Manasseh the father of Amon, Amon the father of Josiah,
- 11 and Josiah the father of Jeconiah and his brothers, at the time of the deportation to Babylon. [cf. 1 Chr 3:10–14]

### Exile (Jeconiah/Jehoiachin) to Jesus

- 12 After the deportation to Babylon, Jeconiah became the father of Shealtiel, Shealtiel the father of Zerubbabel,
- 13 Zerubbabel the father of Abiud, Abiud the father of Eliakim, Eliakim the father of Azor,
- 14 Azor the father of Zadok, Zadok the father of Achim, Achim the father of Eliud,
- 15 Eliud the father of Eleazar, Eleazar the father of Matthan, Matthan the father of Jacob,
- 16 and Jacob the father of Joseph, the husband of Mary, by whom Jesus was born, who is called Christ.

## **Summary**

17 So all the generations from Abraham to David are fourteen generations, and from David to the deportation to Babylon, fourteen generations, and from the deportation to Babylon to Christ, fourteen generations.

- 30 the son of Simeon, the son of Judah, the son of Joseph, the son of Jonam, the son of Eliakim,

- 32 the son of Jesse, the son of Obed, the son of Boaz, the son of Sala, the son of Nahshon,
- 33 the son of Amminadab, the son of Admin, the son of Arni, the son of Hezron, the son of Perez, the son of Judah, 34a the son of Jacob, the son of Isaac, the son of Abraham,

#### **Abraham to Adam**

- 34b the son of Terah, the son of Nahor,
- 35 the son of Serug, the son of Reu, the son of Peleg, the son of Eber, the son of Shelah,

36 the son of Cainan, the son of Arphaxad, the son of Shem, the son of Noah, the son of Lamech, 37 the son of Methuselah, the son of Enoch, the son of Jared, the son of Mahalalel, the son of Kenan, 38 the son of Enosh, the son of Seth, the son of Adam, the son of God.
