# David Prepares to Bring the Ark to Jerusalem (c. 998 BC)

1 Chronicles 13:1-4; 15:1b

- 13:1 Then David consulted with the captains of the thousands and the hundreds, even with every leader.
- 2 David said to all the assembly of Israel, "If it seems good to you, and if it is from the LORD our God, let us send everywhere to our kinsmen who remain in all the land of Israel, also to the priests and Levites who are with them in their cities with pasture lands, that they may meet with us;
- 3 and let us bring back the ark of our God to us, for we did not seek it in the days of Saul."
- 4 Then all the assembly said that they would do so, for the thing was right in the eyes of all the people.

10 And David was unwilling to move the ark of the LORD into the city of David with him; but David took it aside

to the house of Obed-edom the Gittite.

11 Thus the ark of the LORD remained in the house of Obed-edom the Gittite three months, and the LORD blessed Obed-edom and all his household.

11 Then David became angry because of the LORD's outburst against Uzza; and he called that place Perez-uzza to this day.

12 David was afraid of God that day, saying, "How can I bring the ark of God home to me?"

13 So David did not take the ark with him to the city of David, but took it aside

to the house of Obed-edom the Gittite.

14 Thus the ark of God remained with the family of Obed-edom in his house three months; and the LORD blessed the family of Obed-edom with all that he had.

# The Way of the Righteous and the Wicked (c. 998 BC)

### Psalm 1

- 1 How blessed is the man who does not walk in the counsel of the wicked, Nor stand in the path of sinners, Nor sit in the seat of scoffers!
- 2 But his delight is in the law of the LORD, And in His law he meditates day and night.
- 3 He will be like a tree *firmly* planted by streams of water, Which yields its fruit in its season And its leaf does not wither; And in whatever he does, he prospers.
- 4 The wicked are not so,
  - But they are like chaff which the wind drives away.
- 5 Therefore the wicked will not stand in the judgment, Nor sinners in the assembly of the righteous.
- 6 For the LORD knows the way of the righteous, But the way of the wicked will perish.

## The Law of the LORD Is Perfect (c. 998 BC)

#### Psalm 19

For the choir director.

### A Psalm of David.

- 1 The heavens are telling of the glory of God; And their expanse is declaring the work of His hands.
- Day to day pours forth speech,And night to night reveals knowledge.
- 3 There is no speech, nor are there words; Their voice is not heard.
- Their line has gone out through all the earth,
  And their utterances to the end of the world. [Rom 1:19–20; 10:17–18]
  In them He has placed a tent for the sun,
- 5 Which is as a bridegroom coming out of his chamber;

It rejoices as a strong man to run his course.

- 6 Its rising is from one end of the heavens,
  - And its circuit to the other end of them;
  - And there is nothing hidden from its heat.
- 7 The law of the LORD is perfect, restoring the soul; The testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple.
- 8 The precepts of the LORD are right, rejoicing the heart; The commandment of the LORD is pure, enlightening the eyes.
- 9 The fear of the LORD is clean, enduring forever;
  The judgments of the LORD are true; they are righteous altogether.
- 10 They are more desirable than gold, yes, than much fine gold; Sweeter also than honey and the drippings of the honeycomb.
- 11 Moreover, by them Your servant is warned; In keeping them there is great reward.
- 12 Who can discern his errors? Acquit me of hidden faults.
- 13 Also keep back Your servant from presumptuous *sins*; Let them not rule over me; Then I will be blameless, And I shall be acquitted of great transgression.
- 14 Let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heartBe acceptable in Your sight,O LORD, my rock and my Redeemer.
