1) The Israelites carefully obeyed God's command to number the people for <u>war</u> and His instructions concerning the encampment and <u>marching</u> order of each tribe (Num 1–2). This reminds us that faithful obedience is necessary no matter <u>what</u> God's directive may be. God intended the <u>men</u>—not the women, the children, or the Levites—to wage war against the Canaanites, personally putting them to death with the <u>sword</u>. This meant that each individual's commitment and faith in God would be put to the <u>test</u>. God promised Israel the land of Canaan, but their possession of the land came through <u>war</u>. In the same way, we must claim God's promised victory over the world by waging <u>spiritual</u> war (Eph 6:10–13). Are we being faithful to strap on our swords and do battle with the enemy in God's name?
