Psalm 48

A song. A psalm of the sons of Korah.

- Yahweh is great and very worthy of praise in the city of our God, in his holy mountain.
- Beautiful in elevation, the joy of the whole earth, 2 is Mount Zion, in the far north, the city of the great king. [Matt 5:34-35]
- 3 God is in her citadels;

he is known as a *high* stronghold.

- 4 For see, the kings assembled;
 - they advanced together.
- 5 They themselves saw it, so they were astonished.
 - They were terrified; they ran off.
- 6 Trembling seized them there pain as of a woman in labor.
- 7 With an east wind
 - you shatter the ships of Tarshish.
- 8 As we have heard, so we have seen in the city of Yahweh of hosts, in the city of our God. God will establish her forever. Selah
- 9 We have pondered your loyal love, O God, in the midst of your temple.
- 10 As is your name, O God, so is your praise to the ends of the earth. Your right hand is full of righteousness.
- 11 Let Mount Zion rejoice;

let the daughters of Judah rejoice because of your judgments.

- 12 Walk about Zion and circle it;
- count her towers. 13 Consider well her ramparts.

Go through her citadels

so that you can tell the next generation

that this is God, our God forever and ever.

He himself will guide us until death.

Why Should I Fear in Times of Trouble (c. David/Solomon)

Psalm 49

For the music director.

Of the sons of Korah. A psalm.

- Hear this, all you peoples; 1 give ear, all you inhabitants of the world,
- 2 both low and high, rich and poor together.
- 3 My mouth will speak wisdom,
 - and the meditation of my heart will be understanding.
- 4 I will incline my ear to a proverb; I will propound my riddle on a lyre.
 - Why should I fear in times of calamity,
- 5 when iniquity surrounds me at my heels,
- 6 those who trust their wealth
 - and boast about the abundance of their riches?
- 7 Surely a man cannot redeem a brother.
 - He cannot give to God his ransom
- (since the redemption price for their life is costly

and it always fails),

- 9 so that he may stay alive forever *and* not see the pit.
- 10 For he sees *that* the wise die, together *with the* fool and brute they perish, and leave their wealth to the next *generation*.
- 11 Within them *they think* their houses *are* forever, their dwelling places from generation to generation. They name *their* lands by their *own* names.
- 12 But man cannot continue in *his* pomp. He is like the beasts *that* perish.
- 13 This is the journey of those who have foolish confidence, and those after them who accept their sayings. Selah
- Like sheep they are destined to Sheol; death will shepherd them.
 But the upright will rule over them in the morning, and their forms will be for Sheol to consume, far from his lofty abode.
- 15 Surely God will ransom my life from the power of Sheol, because he will receive me. *Selah*
- Do not fear when a man becomes rich, when the wealth of his house increases,
- because when he dies he will not take away any of it.
 His wealth will not follow down after him.
 Though he congratulated his soul while he was living
- —and *people* will praise you when you do well for yourself—
 it will go to the generation of his fathers.
- Never will they see light.
- Humankind in *its* pomp, but does not understand, is like the beasts *that* perish.

Psalm 84

For the music director; on the Gittith.

Of the sons of Korah. A psalm.

- 1 How lovely *are* your dwelling places,
 - O Yahweh of hosts!
- 2 My soul longs and even fails
 - for the courtyards of Yahweh.
 - My heart and flesh sing for joy
 - to the living God.
- B Even a bird finds a home, and a swallow a nest for herself,
 - where she may lay her young,
 - near your altars, O Yahweh of hosts,
 - my king and my God.
- 4 Blessed *are* those who dwell in your house;
 - they can ever praise you. Selah
- 5 Blessed *is the* man whose strength *is* in you; in their heart *are the* highways *to Zion*.
- 6 Passing through the Valley of Baca,
 - they make it a spring.
 - The early rain covers it with blessings as well.
- 7 They go from strength to strength,
 - until each appears before God in Zion.
- 8 O Yahweh, God of hosts, hear my prayer; give ear, O God of Jacob. *Selah*

- 9 Look at our shield, O God,
 - and have regard for the face of your anointed one.
- 10 Because better is a day in your courtyards
 - than a thousand elsewhere.
 - I would rather be at the threshold of the house of my God
 - than to dwell in the tents of wickedness.
- 11 Because Yahweh God is a sun and a shield;
 - Yahweh gives grace and honor.
 - He does not withhold good from those who walk blamelessly.
- 12 O Yahweh of hosts,
 - blessed is the man who trusts you.

 - and annul your vexation with us.
 - Will you be angry against us forever?
 Will you prolong your anger generation after generation?
