

Great Are the Lord's Works (c. David/Solomon/Divided Kingdom)

Psalm 111

- 1 Praise Yah!
I will give thanks to Yahweh with all *my* heart,
in *the* assembly of *the* upright and *the* congregation.
- 2 The works of Yahweh *are* great,
studied by all *who* delight *in* them.
- 3 *Full of* splendor and majesty *is* his work,
and his righteousness endures forever.
- 4 He has made his wonders to be remembered;
Yahweh *is* gracious and compassionate.
- 5 He gives food to those who fear him;
he remembers his covenant forever.
- 6 He has declared the power of his works for his people,
by giving to them *the* inheritance of *the* nations.
- 7 The works of his hands *are* faithfulness and justice;
all his precepts *are* reliable.
- 8 *They are* sustained forever *and ever*,
done with faithfulness and uprightness.
- 9 He has sent redemption to his people;
he has commanded his covenant forever;
holy and fearful *is* his name.
- 10 The fear of Yahweh *is the* beginning of wisdom;
all who do them have a good understanding.
His praise endures forever.

The Righteous Will Never Be Moved (c. David/Solomon/Divided Kingdom)

Psalm 112

- 1 Praise Yah! Blessed *is the* man *who* fears Yahweh;
he takes great delight in his commands.
- 2 His descendants will be mighty in the land;
the generation of *the* upright will be blessed.
- 3 Wealth and riches *are* in his house,
and his righteousness endures forever.
- 4 *His* light rises in the darkness for the upright;
he is gracious and compassionate and righteous.
- 5 *It goes well for* a man *who* is gracious and lends,
who conducts his business properly.
- 6 For he will not be shaken forever;
the righteous will be remembered forever.
- 7 He is not afraid of bad news;
his heart *is* steadfast, secure in Yahweh.
- 8 His heart *is* sustained; he will not be afraid,
until he looks *in triumph* on his enemies.
- 9 He gives lavishly to the needy;
his righteousness endures forever. [2 Cor 9:9]
His horn rises high in honor.
- 10 *The* wicked sees *it* and is vexed.
He gnashes his teeth and becomes weak.
The desire of *the* wicked perishes.

Who Is like the Lord Our God? (c. David/Solomon/Divided Kingdom)

Psalm 113

- 1 Praise Yah!
Praise, O servants of Yahweh,

- praise the name of Yahweh.
- 2 Let the name of Yahweh be blessed,
from now until forever.
- 3 From *the* rising of *the* sun to its setting,
let the name of Yahweh be blessed.
- 4 Yahweh *is* high above all nations;
his glory *is* above the heavens.
- 5 Who *is* like Yahweh our God,
who *is* enthroned on high,
- 6 who condescends to look at
what is in the heavens and in the earth?
- 7 *He* raises *the* helpless from *the* dust;
he lifts *the* needy from *the* ash heap,
- 8 to seat *them* with princes,
with the princes of his people.
- 9 *He* causes the barren woman of the house to dwell
as the happy mother of children.
Praise Yah!

Tremble at the Presence of the Lord (c. David/Solomon/Divided Kingdom)

Psalm 114

- 1 When Israel went out from Egypt,
the house of Jacob from a people of a strange language,
- 2 Judah became his sanctuary,
Israel his dominion.
- 3 The sea looked and fled;
the Jordan turned back.
- 4 The mountains skipped like rams,
the hills like lambs.
- 5 What's with you, O sea, *that* you fled?
O Jordan, *that* you turned back?
- 6 O mountains, *that* you skipped like rams?
O hills, like lambs?
- 7 At the presence of *the* Lord writhe, O earth,
at the presence of the God of Jacob,
- 8 who turned the rock into a pool of water,
flinty stone into a spring of water.

To Your Name Give Glory (c. David/Solomon/Divided Kingdom)

Psalm 115

- 1 Not to us, O Yahweh, not to us,
but to your name give glory,
because of your loyal love,
because of your faithfulness.
- 2 Why should the nations say,
"Where, pray tell, *is* their God?"
- 3 But our God *is* in the heavens;
all that he desires, he does.
- 4 Their idols *are* silver and gold,
the work of human hands.
- 5 They have mouths, but cannot speak;
they have eyes, but cannot see;
- 6 they have ears, but cannot hear;
they have noses, but cannot smell;
- 7 *they have* their hands, but they cannot feel,
their feet, but they cannot walk;

- they cannot utter a sound in their throats.
- 8 *Those who* make them become like them,
as does everyone who trusts in them.
- 9 O Israel, trust Yahweh;
he *is* their help and their shield.
- 10 O house of Aaron, trust in Yahweh;
he *is* their help and their shield.
- 11 *You who* fear Yahweh, trust in Yahweh;
he *is* their help and their shield.
- 12 Yahweh remembers us; he will bless *us*.
He will bless the house of Israel;
he will bless the house of Aaron.
- 13 He will bless *those who* fear Yahweh,
the small with the great.
- 14 May Yahweh give you increase,
you and your children.
- 15 May you be blessed by Yahweh,
who made heaven and earth.
- 16 The heavens *are* Yahweh's heavens,
but the earth he has given to *the* children of humankind.
- 17 The dead do not praise Yah,
nor any descending into silence.
- 18 *It is* we, we will bless Yah
from now until forever.
Praise Yah!

I Love the Lord (c. David/Solomon/Divided Kingdom)

Psalm 116

- 1 I love *him*, because Yahweh has heard
the voice of my supplications.
- 2 Because he has inclined his ear to me,
I will call all my days.
- 3 *The* ropes of death encircled me,
and the distresses of Sheol found me.
I found trouble and grief.
- 4 Then I called on the name of Yahweh:
"O Yahweh, please save my life!"
- 5 Gracious *is* Yahweh and righteous,
and our God *is* merciful.
- 6 Yahweh watches over *the* simple.
I was brought low, but he gave me victory.
- 7 Return, O my soul, to your repose,
for Yahweh has dealt bountifully with you.
- 8 For you have rescued me from death,
my eyes from tears, my feet from stumbling.
- 9 I will walk before Yahweh
in the land of the living.
- 10 I believed when I spoke,
"I am afflicted greatly." [2 Cor 4:13]
- 11 I said in my haste,
"Everyone *is* a liar."
- 12 What shall I give back to Yahweh
for all his benefits to me?
- 13 I will lift up *the* cup of salvation
and proclaim the name of Yahweh.
- 14 I will pay my vows *made* to Yahweh
in the presence of all his people.

- 15 Costly in Yahweh's view *is*
the death of his faithful *ones*.
- 16 Ah, Yahweh, I *am* indeed your servant;
I am your servant, the child of your maidservant.
You have loosed my bonds.
- 17 I will offer to you a sacrifice of thanksgiving,
and proclaim the name of Yahweh.
- 18 I will pay my vows *made* to Yahweh
in the presence of all his people,
- 19 in the courts of the house of Yahweh,
in the midst of you, O Jerusalem.
Praise Yah!

The Lord's Faithfulness Endures Forever (c. David/Solomon/Divided Kingdom)

Psalm 117

- 1 Praise Yahweh, all you nations;
extol him, all you peoples. [[Rom 15:11](#)]
- 2 For his loyal love *is* mighty on our behalf,
and the faithfulness of Yahweh *is* forever.
Praise Yah!

His Steadfast Love Endures Forever [Messianic] (c. David/Solomon/Divided Kingdom)

Psalm 118

- 1 Give thanks to Yahweh for *he is* good,
for his loyal love *is* forever.
- 2 Let Israel say,
"His loyal love *is* forever."
- 3 Let the house of Aaron say,
"His loyal love *is* forever."
- 4 Let *those who* fear Yahweh say,
"His loyal love *is* forever."
- 5 Out of *my* distress I called to Yah.
Yah answered me, *setting me* in a broad place.
- 6 Yahweh *is* for me; I do not fear.
What can *mere* humans do to me? [[Heb 13:6](#)]
- 7 Yahweh *is* for me as my helper,
and *so* I will look *in triumph* on those who hate me.
- 8 *It is* better to take refuge in Yahweh
than to trust in humans.
- 9 *It is* better to take refuge in Yahweh
than to trust princes.
- 10 All nations surrounded me.
In the name of Yahweh I opposed them indeed.
- 11 They surrounded me; yes, they surrounded me.
In the name of Yahweh I opposed them indeed.
- 12 They surrounded me like bees;
they were extinguished like a fire of thorns.
In the name of Yahweh I opposed them indeed.
- 13 You pushed me hard to *make me* fall,
but Yahweh helped me.
- 14 Yah *is* my strength and *my* song,
and he has become my salvation.
- 15 *The* sound of rejoicing and salvation
is in *the* tents of *the* righteous;
the right hand of Yahweh *has* done valiantly.
- 16 The right hand of Yahweh *has* exalted;

- the right hand of Yahweh *has* done valiantly.
- 17 I will not die but live,
and tell of the works of Yah.
- 18 Yah has disciplined me severely,
but he did not consign me to death.
- 19 Open to me *the* gates of righteousness,
that I may enter through them
and give thanks to Yah.
- 20 This *is* the gate of Yahweh,
through *which the* righteous will enter.
- 21 I will give thanks *to* you for you have answered me,
and you have become my salvation.
- 22 *The* stone the builders rejected
has become *the* chief cornerstone.
- 23 This is from Yahweh;
it is wonderful in our eyes. [[Matt 21:42](#); [Mark 12:10, 11](#); [Luke 20:17](#); [Acts 4:11](#); [1 Pet 2:4, 7](#)]
- 24 This *is* the day Yahweh has worked;
let us rejoice and be glad in him.
- 25 O Yahweh, please save;
O Yahweh, please grant success.
- 26 Blessed *is* he who comes in the name of Yahweh.

- 27 Yahweh is God, and he has given us light.
Bind *the* festal sacrifice with cords

You are my God; I will exalt you.
- 29 Give thanks to Yahweh for *he is* good,
for his loyal love *is* forever.
