

## My Refuge and My Fortress (c. David/Solomon/Divided Kingdom)

### Psalm 91

- 1 He who dwells in the shelter of the Most High  
Will abide in the shadow of the Almighty.
- 2 I will say to the LORD, "My refuge and my fortress,  
My God, in whom I trust!"
- 3 For it is He who delivers you from the snare of the trapper  
And from the deadly pestilence.
- 4 He will cover you with His pinions,  
And under His wings you may seek refuge;  
His faithfulness is a shield and bulwark.
- 5 You will not be afraid of the terror by night,  
Or of the arrow that flies by day;
- 6 Of the pestilence that stalks in darkness,  
Or of the destruction that lays waste at noon.
- 7 A thousand may fall at your side  
And ten thousand at your right hand,  
*But* it shall not approach you.
- 8 You will only look on with your eyes  
And see the recompense of the wicked.
- 9 For you have made the LORD, my refuge,  
*Even* the Most High, your dwelling place.
- 10 No evil will befall you,  
Nor will any plague come near your tent.
- 11 For He will give His angels charge concerning you,  
To guard you in all your ways. [[Matt 4:6; Luke 4:10-11](#)]
- 12 They will bear you up in their hands,  
That you do not strike your foot against a stone.
- 13 You will tread upon the lion and cobra,  
The young lion and the serpent you will trample down. [[Luke 10:19](#)]
- 14 "Because he has loved Me, therefore I will deliver him;  
I will set him *securely* on high, because he has known My name.
- 15 "He will call upon Me, and I will answer him;  
I will be with him in trouble;  
I will rescue him and honor him.
- 16 "With a long life I will satisfy him  
And let him see My salvation."

## How Great Are Your Works (c. David/Solomon/Divided Kingdom)

### Psalm 92

#### A Psalm, a Song for the Sabbath day.

- 1 It is good to give thanks to the LORD  
And to sing praises to Your name, O Most High;
- 2 To declare Your lovingkindness in the morning  
And Your faithfulness by night,
- 3 With the ten-stringed lute and with the harp,  
With resounding music upon the lyre.
- 4 For You, O LORD, have made me glad by what You have done,  
I will sing for joy at the works of Your hands.
- 5 How great are Your works, O LORD!  
Your thoughts are very deep.
- 6 A senseless man has no knowledge,  
Nor does a stupid man understand this:
- 7 That when the wicked sprouted up like grass  
And all who did iniquity flourished,  
It *was only* that they might be destroyed forevermore.
- 8 But You, O LORD, are on high forever.

- 9 For, behold, Your enemies, O LORD,  
For, behold, Your enemies will perish;  
All who do iniquity will be scattered.
- 10 But You have exalted my horn like *that of* the wild ox;  
I have been anointed with fresh oil.
- 11 And my eye has looked *exultantly* upon my foes,  
My ears hear of the evildoers who rise up against me.
- 12 The righteous man will flourish like the palm tree,  
He will grow like a cedar in Lebanon.
- 13 Planted in the house of the LORD,  
They will flourish in the courts of our God.
- 14 They will still yield fruit in old age;  
They shall be full of sap and very green,
- 15 To declare that the LORD is upright;  
*He is* my rock, and there is no unrighteousness in Him.

### The LORD Reigns (c. David/Solomon/Divided Kingdom)

Psalm 93

- 1 The LORD reigns, He is clothed with majesty;  
The LORD has clothed and girded Himself with strength;  
Indeed, the world is firmly established, it will not be moved.
- 2 Your throne is established from of old;  
You are from everlasting.
- 3 The floods have lifted up, O LORD,  
The floods have lifted up their voice,  
The floods lift up their pounding waves.
- 4 More than the sounds of many waters,  
*Than* the mighty breakers of the sea,  
The LORD on high is mighty.
- 5 Your testimonies are fully confirmed;  
Holiness befits Your house,  
O LORD, forevermore.

### The LORD Will Not Forsake His People (c. David/Solomon/Divided Kingdom)

Psalm 94

- 1 O LORD, God of vengeance,  
God of vengeance, shine forth!
- 2 Rise up, O Judge of the earth,  
Render recompense to the proud.
- 3 How long shall the wicked, O LORD,  
How long shall the wicked exult?
- 4 They pour forth *words*, they speak arrogantly;  
All who do wickedness vaunt themselves.
- 5 They crush Your people, O LORD,  
And afflict Your heritage.
- 6 They slay the widow and the stranger  
And murder the orphans.
- 7 They have said, "The LORD does not see,  
Nor does the God of Jacob pay heed."
- 8 Pay heed, you senseless among the people;  
And when will you understand, stupid ones?
- 9 He who planted the ear, does He not hear?  
He who formed the eye, does He not see?
- 10 He who chastens the nations, will He not rebuke,  
*Even* He who teaches man knowledge?
- 11 The LORD knows the thoughts of man,

- That they are a *mere* breath. [[1 Cor 3:20](#)]
- 12 Blessed is the man whom You chasten, O LORD,  
And whom You teach out of Your law;
- 13 That You may grant him relief from the days of adversity,  
Until a pit is dug for the wicked.
- 14 For the LORD will not abandon His people,  
Nor will He forsake His inheritance. [[Rom 11:2](#)]
- 15 For judgment will again be righteous,  
And all the upright in heart will follow it.
- 16 Who will stand up for me against evildoers?  
Who will take his stand for me against those who do wickedness?
- 17 If the LORD had not been my help,  
My soul would soon have dwelt in *the abode of* silence.
- 18 If I should say, "My foot has slipped,"  
Your lovingkindness, O LORD, will hold me up.
- 19 When my anxious thoughts multiply within me,  
Your consolations delight my soul.
- 20 Can a throne of destruction be allied with You,  
One which devises mischief by decree?
- 21 They band themselves together against the life of the righteous  
And condemn the innocent to death.
- 22 But the LORD has been my stronghold,  
And my God the rock of my refuge.
- 23 He has brought back their wickedness upon them  
And will destroy them in their evil;  
The LORD our God will destroy them.

### The LORD Reigns (c. David/Solomon/Divided Kingdom)

#### Psalm 97

- 1 The LORD reigns, let the earth rejoice;  
Let the many islands be glad.
- 2 Clouds and thick darkness surround Him;  
Righteousness and justice are the foundation of His throne.
- 3 Fire goes before Him  
And burns up His adversaries round about.
- 4 His lightnings lit up the world;  
The earth saw and trembled.
- 5 The mountains melted like wax at the presence of the LORD,  
At the presence of the Lord of the whole earth.
- 6 The heavens declare His righteousness,  
And all the peoples have seen His glory.
- 7 Let all those be ashamed who serve graven images,  
Who boast themselves of idols;  
Worship Him, all you gods.
- 8 Zion heard *this* and was glad,  
And the daughters of Judah have rejoiced  
Because of Your judgments, O LORD.
- 9 For You are the LORD Most High over all the earth;  
You are exalted far above all gods.
- 10 Hate evil, you who love the LORD,  
Who preserves the souls of His godly ones;  
He delivers them from the hand of the wicked.
- 11 Light is sown *like seed* for the righteous  
And gladness for the upright in heart.
- 12 Be glad in the LORD, you righteous ones,  
And give thanks to His holy name.

## Make a Joyful Noise to the LORD (c. David/Solomon/Divided Kingdom)

### Psalm 98

**A Psalm.**

- 1 O sing to the LORD a new song,  
For He has done wonderful things,  
His right hand and His holy arm have gained the victory for Him.
- 2 The LORD has made known His salvation;  
He has revealed His righteousness in the sight of the nations.
- 3 He has remembered His lovingkindness and His faithfulness to the house of Israel;  
All the ends of the earth have seen the salvation of our God.
- 4 Shout joyfully to the LORD, all the earth;  
Break forth and sing for joy and sing praises.
- 5 Sing praises to the LORD with the lyre,  
With the lyre and the sound of melody.
- 6 With trumpets and the sound of the horn  
Shout joyfully before the King, the LORD.
- 7 Let the sea roar and all it contains,  
The world and those who dwell in it.
- 8 Let the rivers clap their hands,  
Let the mountains sing together for joy
- 9 Before the LORD, for He is coming to judge the earth;  
He will judge the world with righteousness  
And the peoples with equity.

## The LORD Our God Is Holy (c. David/Solomon/Divided Kingdom)

### Psalm 99

- 1 The LORD reigns, let the peoples tremble;  
He is enthroned *above* the cherubim, let the earth shake!
- 2 The LORD is great in Zion,  
And He is exalted above all the peoples.
- 3 Let them praise Your great and awesome name;  
Holy is He.
- 4 The strength of the King loves justice;  
You have established equity;  
You have executed justice and righteousness in Jacob.
- 5 Exalt the LORD our God  
And worship at His footstool;  
Holy is He.
- 6 Moses and Aaron were among His priests,  
And Samuel was among those who called on His name;  
They called upon the LORD and He answered them.
- 7 He spoke to them in the pillar of cloud;  
They kept His testimonies  
And the statute that He gave them.
- 8 O LORD our God, You answered them;  
You were a forgiving God to them,  
And yet an avenger of their *evil* deeds.
- 9 Exalt the LORD our God  
And worship at His holy hill,  
For holy is the LORD our God.
