1) David's psalms. Psalm 26 shows us the peace and confidence that comes from a clear <u>conscience</u>. David said, "Vindicate [judge] me, O LORD, for I have walked in my integrity, and I have trusted in the LORD without wavering. Prove me, O LORD, and <u>try</u> me; <u>test</u> my heart and my mind" (Ps 26:1–2). This teaches us that it's possible for our lives to pass the scrutiny of God's searching eye! How can this be done? By <u>keeping</u> His lovingkindness before our eyes (Ps 26:3a), by <u>walking</u> in the truth (Ps 26:3b), by <u>rejecting</u> the company of evil men (Ps 26:4–5), by <u>washing</u> ourselves in His cleansing blood (Ps 26:6), and by <u>loving</u> Him with all our heart (Ps 26:8). David is a testament to the fact that we can live a life of <u>innocence</u> and integrity, and that we too can stand "on level ground" (Ps 26:12).
