1) David's preparations for the construction of the temple. This reading teaches us the importance of organization and planning for the future. David worked hard to make sure that Solomon would inherit a functional, efficient and robust administration. David's organization of the Levites shows that there were many ways to contribute to the ministry of the temple. Some cleaned the courts and chambers (1 Chr 23:28), some helped with cooking the showbread (1 Chr 23:29), some worshipped God with music and song (1 Chr 25), some were gatekeepers (1 Chr 26:1–19), and some were in charge of God's treasuries (1 Chr 26:20–28). The rest of the tribes gave tithes to support the Levites as they served in the temple and joined with them in worship. In this way, everyone had a part in the work of the ministry. This shows that all of us have a part to play in God's service. The Holy Spirit has given each of us a gift that we can use to build up Christ's body (cf. 1 Cor 12:4–7). We should develop our gifts and use them to the best of our ability (Rom 12:4–8).
