

### Daniel 2

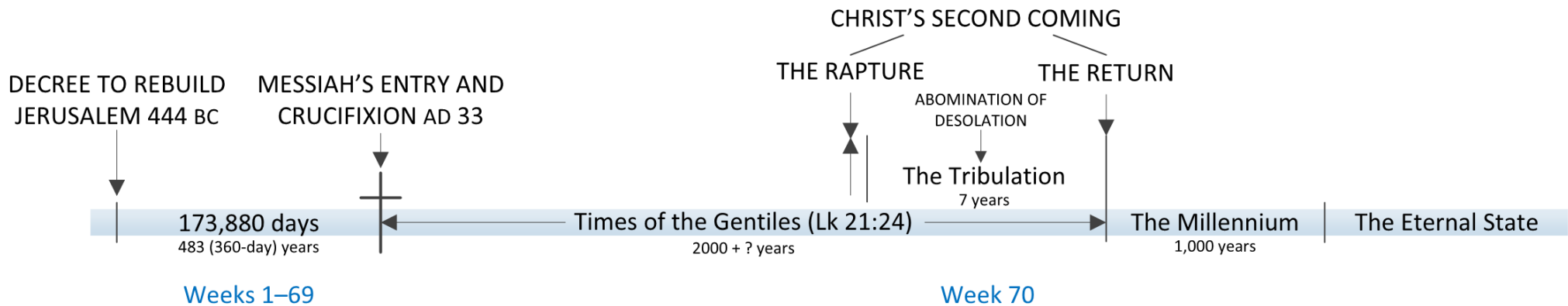
- Terrifying statue made of four metals.
- The four metals represented four different empires that would rule the known world: Babylon, Medo-Persia, Greece, and Rome.
- The last empire, Rome, will have a final phase, Rome II, signified by the iron-clay feet.
- A stone, representing Christ, will destroy the statue and become a huge mountain filling the earth.

### Daniel 7

- Night vision of the four beasts.
- The four beasts represented four different empires that would rule the known world: Babylon, Medo-Persia, Greece, and Rome.
- The last beast, Rome, will have a final phase, Rome II, signified by ten horns. Then a little horn, the Antichrist, will defeat them and reign supreme.
- Christ will return to earth, defeat the Antichrist, and establish His kingdom.

### Daniel 9

- The 70 'weeks' or 490 years (9:24).
- In the first seven 'weeks' (49 years), Jerusalem would be rebuilt.
- In the next 62 'weeks' (434 years), the Messiah would appear and enter Jerusalem.
- In the gap between the 69<sup>th</sup> 'week' and the 70<sup>th</sup> 'week,' the Messiah would be cut off and Jerusalem destroyed.
- In the final 'week' (the 70<sup>th</sup> 'week'), the Antichrist would come and desecrate the Temple.
- Christ returns, defeats the Antichrist, and establishes His kingdom.



- **Futurist:** Regards many prophetic texts (e.g., Rev 4-22) as describing real people and events which have not yet occurred (but will in the future).
- **Premillennial:** Jesus Christ will return to this present earth *before* (pre) the Millennium. He will then personally rule for 1,000 years over a literal, physical, earthly kingdom.
- **Pre-Tribulation Rapture:** The church will be taken away before the beginning of Daniel's 70<sup>th</sup> 'week,' the Tribulation.
