- 1) Moses' Second Sermon (Part 1a). This sermon focused on the _____ God made with Israel at Mount Sinai, and it called the people to covenant _____ and obedience. Moses emphasized that the covenant had been made with the _____ of Israel, and thus it applied to _____ Israelites for generations to come (Deut 5:3). Moses repeated the Ten Commandments which God had spoken audibly from the mountain, and he recalled how pleased God was when the people _____ Him and wanted to obey. Moses then gave them the greatest commandment: "You shall _____ the LORD your God with all your _____ and with all your _____ and with all your _____" (Deut 6:5; Matt 22:37–38). Moses continued by pointing out that loving God meant _____ His words to their children and being diligent to _____ why His laws were the foundation of their lives. As Christians, we too have entered into a covenant relationship with God. This covenant is the _____ Covenant spoken of by Jeremiah and mediated through the blood of God's Son, Jesus Christ (cf. Jer 31:31–34; Heb 8). This covenant also has _____ and guidelines for our behavior, namely, loving God and loving others (cf. Matt 22:34–40).
