1)	Moses' third and final sermon. Moses began by reminding the people of what they had seen and
	heard (Deut 29:3). Then Moses said, "But to this day the LORD has not given you a heart to
	or eyes to or ears to " (Deut 29:4; cf. Isa 6:9–10; Matt 13:14–15)
	How could this be? Was it somehow God's fault? Certainly not! Such gifts can only be given to those
	who come to God in sincere and God can give anyone water from a
	rock and manna from heaven. God can give anyone clothes that don't wear out and sandals that
	don't wear off. But inner, change can only come to those who respond to God in
	faith! But surely God's Law was too for them to know and too for them to
	keep? No! God told the people clearly that His Law was not too hard and it was not too far away. "It
	is in your mouth and in your heart, so that you do it" (Deut 30:14). Moses then told the
	people that he would not be going with them into Canaan (Deut 31:3). This teaches us that while
	leadership may change, God's guiding and protecting presence remains the same. We
	can be strong and courageous because God is with us.
