## May 14 Questions

1) The last of David's psalms. Psalm 145 is an \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ of praise. It is the last Davidic psalm in the Psalter and the last of his \_\_\_\_\_\_ psalms (cf. Ps 9, 10, 25, 34, 37, 145). In this psalm, David sings the praises of the King: God's greatness is beyond all measure (v. 3), God has done mighty \_\_\_\_\_\_ (v. 4), the glorious splendor of God's majesty is worthy of \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ (v. 5), God is good and righteous (v. 7), God is kind, merciful, patient, loving, and compassionate (vv. 8–9), God's Kingdom will never end (v. 13), God provides for our daily \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ (vv. 15–16), God is righteous and kind in all His ways (v. 17), God is \_\_\_\_\_\_ to all who call on Him (v. 18), God fulfills the desire of those who \_\_\_\_\_\_ Him (v. 19), and God hears our cry and rescues us from our distress (vv. 19–20).
