In this psalm, David sings the praises of the King: God's greatness is beyond all measure (v. 3), God has done mighty _____ (v. 4), the glorious splendor of God's majesty is worthy of _____ (v. 5), God is good and righteous (v. 7), God is kind, merciful, patient, loving, and compassionate (vv. 8–9), God's Kingdom will never end (v. 13), God provides for our daily _____ (vv. 15–16), God is righteous and kind in all His ways (v. 17), God is _____ to all who call on Him (v. 18), God fulfills the desire of those who _____ Him (v. 19), and God hears our cry and rescues us from our distress (vv. 19–20).
