- 1) Psalm 102 is the prayer of “one _____” (v. 1). In the _____, the prayer ends with v. 22, and the rest of the psalm is God’s answer to the psalmist, who is called “_____” in v. 25. This means the psalm is _____. The author of _____ later quoted Ps 102 as a statement made by the _____ to the _____, and he used it to show that the Messiah, the Son, is greater than the _____ (Heb 1:10–12; Ps 102:25–27). Thus the psalm speaks first of the Messiah’s suffering (vv. 1–11), and then of His anticipation of the future Kingdom (vv. 12–22). At the end, the Father told Jesus that the days of His _____ life would indeed be few (vv. 23–24), but then God reminded Him that He was the _____ of the heavens: “They may perish, but you remain...your years will have no end” (vv. 26–27). Thus Psalm 102 is a beautiful testament to the _____ of God’s Son, Jesus Christ!
