

## August 11 Questions

- 1) Jeremiah cried out against the false \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ who claimed to speak in God's name. The people would ask one of the false prophets what message he had from God, and the false prophet would claim to have "the \_\_\_\_\_ (*massa*) of the LORD!" God was so angry at their lies that He actually commanded the people never to say those words again. If they did, God would pick them up and \_\_\_\_\_ them out of His presence (Jer 23:36–40). Jeremiah's experience teaches us how to identify false prophets today: (1) they do not hold people \_\_\_\_\_ for sin, (2) they tell people what they want to \_\_\_\_\_, (3) they do not live careful, \_\_\_\_\_ lives, and (4) their message \_\_\_\_\_ the clear teaching of Scripture.
